**IMMERSIVE ROOM 1:
360 DEGREE
LIFE OF JESUS**

Experience Jesus' life through an immersive cinematic journey at Christ Cathedral's Resurrection Exhibit. State of the art projections bring 10 pivotal stories to life, from the annunciation to the crucifixion. Witness key moments like the nativity, baptism, miracles, and Last Supper in stunning detail. The experience concludes with the crucifixion and entombment. This powerful encounter makes ancient history feel immediate and relevant for all audiences, offering a unique way to connect with Jesus' story.



**INTERACTIVE ROOM 2:
FAITH & FORENSICS
OF THE SHROUD**

The Shroud room offers a state of the art multimedia presentation on this extensively studied artifact. A short film explores its mysterious origins and recent scientific findings. High-resolution images reveal intricate details, including the 3D-encoded image, bloodstains, and pollen traces from ancient Jerusalem. The presentation concludes with animations visualizing theories about the image's formation during the resurrection, blending scientific inquiry with faith.



**IMMERSIVE ROOM 3:
THE REALITY OF
THE RESURRECTION**

The 3rd room offers a 4-D immersive experience of post-resurrection events. Witness Jesus appearing to his disciples, Thomas touching his wounds, and 500 people seeing the risen Christ. Experience medieval architecture, candlelight, and Gregorian chants while viewing the Shroud as it appeared centuries ago. This journey through time brings resurrection stories to life and the real presence of Jesus for today. The experience concludes with quiet contemplation of the question: "Who Do You Say That I Am?"



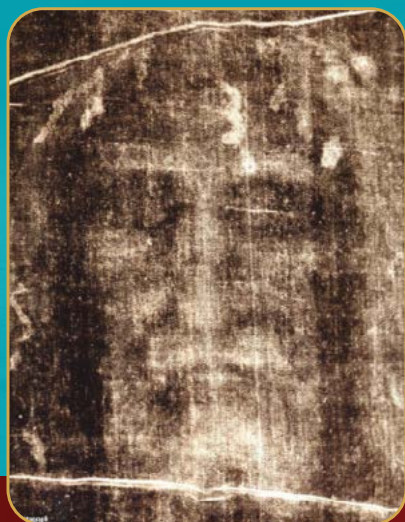
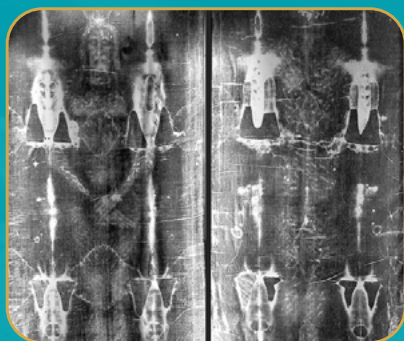
THE OTHONIA SHROUD EXPERIENCE

The museum offers a comprehensive exploration of the Shroud of Turin. Features include:

- Life-size Shroud reproduction
- 30 museum panels

- LED displays on Shroud's history & science
- Bronze statue of the life-size "Man of the Shroud"
- Holograms and passion object reconstructions
- Hands-on scientific exhibits from Othonia
- Scale reproduction of the Holy Sepulcher
- Multimedia history presentation and art mural
- Reverse "Shroud Selfie Station"

Othonia is an international association within the Regina Apostolorum Pontifical Athenaeum's Science and Faith Institute. It focuses on preserving, promoting, and disseminating knowledge about the Shroud of Turin through interdisciplinary research and collaboration. Othonia organizes academic events, maintains Shroud-related collections, and has a Scientific Research Committee with diverse experts. The organization works with other institutions, particularly the Regnum Christi Movement.

The exhibit will operate daily with timed ticketing. The project will create a world-class experience, leveraging existing advantages like the museum-quality building and Vatican exhibit pieces. Once established, it will become self-sustaining and profitable. This unique partnership involves the Diocese of Orange, the Shroud Center of Southern California, Pontifical University Regina Apostolorum in Rome, and international Shroud experts.
